



International Financial Analysis Scholarship Nomination Form

This scholarship is awarded annually to a qualified, non-U.S. citizen master's student who is interested in pursuing a CFA Institute Chartered Financial Analyst (CFA[®]) charter, and is intended to promote professionalism in financial analysis at the international level. This scholarship covers remaining tuition for the Master of Science degree program, as well as the fee for the Level I CFA exam; minus a \$100 (U.S.) administrative fee (study materials and textbooks are not included).

- Deadline for submission of nominations to the College for Financial Planning is April 1 annually.
- Nominations for candidates are accepted from both individuals and companies.
- Applicants will be informed no later than July 31 each year of the scholarship committee's decisions.
- Citizenship Requirements: Applicants must be non-U.S. citizens.
- CFA Requirements: Applicants must fulfill all [CFA Institute Level I CFA candidate requirements](#).

Applicants must mail or fax this completed typed or clearly hand-printed form by April 1 of the current year. Please include: current résumé, statement of goals, and two letters of recommendation from professional contacts. Letters should not exceed one 8½-by-11 inch typed page.
